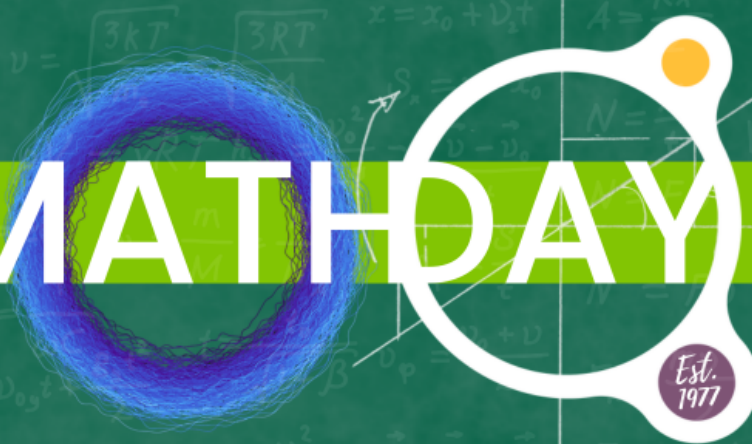

You are invited to attend Math Day at Colorado State University with your school on November 5th, 2026. This is an annual event that hosts around 500 math-enthusiastic high school students from all over Colorado and surrounding areas.

Key events, activities and competitions at Math Day 2026:

+Guest Lecturer: Trevor Hyde, Assistant Professor in the Department of Mathematics and Statistics at Vassar College.

+Quiz Bowl Team Competition: Student teams compete in a double-elimination tournament for both small and large schools. Each team needs a minimum of three students to compete.

+Student Project Math Fair: Create a project for our Student Project portion of the Math Fair in one of these 5 categories:

- Expository: History, Biography & Theory of Mathematics
- Artistic and Recreational Mathematics
- Data Visualization or Mathematics
- Original Mathematical Research
- Mathematics in Education/Teaching

These will be judged by department mathematics instructors for prizes in each category.

Note: Your project needs to have these details attached: project category, project name, student name & school. The physical form of the project is up to the student but must be able to be placed on a table. Any posters must be on a self-standing board (typically 36' x 48" tri-fold cardboard or foam).

+Open House Math Fair: Stop in at the Math Fair at free moments throughout Math Day and engage with math-themed activities, puzzles, and games.
